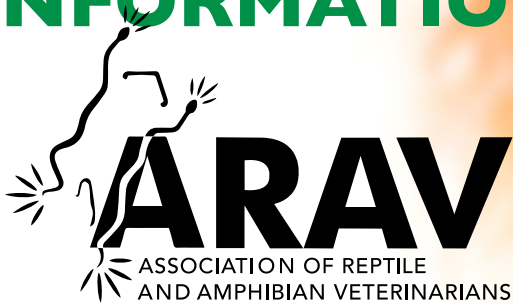


STUDENT MEMBERSHIP INFORMATION

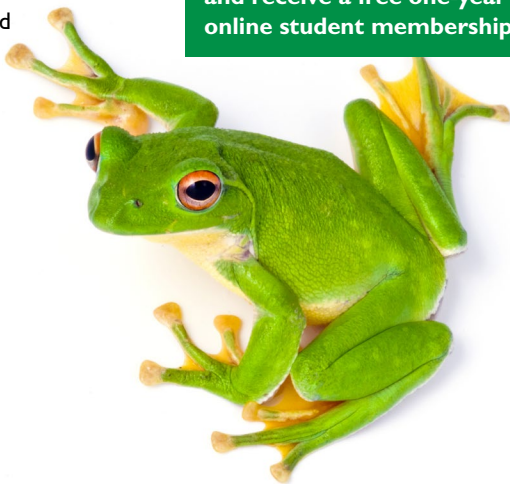
Membership benefits:
